


Troop 407 – Novi, Michigan
Directions to Heritage Reservation and Laurel Caverns
March, 2008

We will be camping at Heritage Reservation, of the Greater Pittsburgh Council, in Farmington, Pennsylvania. The first map shows the entire route, the second map shows from Uniontown, Pa., to camp, and the third map shows the last few miles.

Driving directions:

- Get on **I-275** going southbound. After about 30 miles, merge onto **I-75** southbound.
- Once in Ohio, take **exit 208** (on the left) to merge onto **I-280 Southbound** (toward Ohio Turnpike and Cleveland)
- After about 12 miles, take **exit 1A** to merge onto **I80/90, the Ohio Turnpike**, toward Cleveland (toll road)
- Past Cleveland, almost to Youngstown, the Ohio Turnpike becomes **I-76**. Remain on the Ohio Turnpike (I-76).
- You will cross into Pennsylvania and I-76 becomes the Pennsylvania Turnpike.
- About 75 miles after entering Pennsylvania, take **exit 75** for **I-70 Westbound**, toward Wheeling, W.Va.
- Keeping left at the fork in the road, follow signs for **US-119 / PA-66 Turnpike North** and merge onto **New Stanton Youngwood Rd.** Then, take the exit onto **US-119 Southbound** toward Connellsville. US-119 freeway will end near Mt. Pleasant. Stay on US-119, Memorial Highway. (See the fourth map for details.)
- After about 16.5 miles, in Connellsville, veer slightly right at **Blackstone Road** (still US-119). Blackstone becomes Merrell Rd., then University Dr.
- After about 14 miles, approaching Uniontown, continue on **George C. Marshall Parkway / US 40 East**, then take a slight left at George C. Marshall Parkway/National Pike/US 40 East. (See the fifth map for details)
- Follow **National Pike / US 40 East** 14 miles. Go through Farmington, then turn right on **Dinner Bell Five Forks Road.**
- Heritage Reservation is 2.6 miles ahead on the right.


Map 1 – Entire Route




Map 2 – Uniontown to Camp




Map 3 – Last Few Miles



Map 4 – Exiting Pennsylvania Turnpike




Map 5 – Uniontown Vicinity



Heritage Reservation to Laurel Caverns

- Take Dinner Bell Five Forks Road north from camp about 2.5 miles
- Turn left on **National Pike / US 40** and proceed 8.3 miles
- Turn sharp left at **Skyline Drive**
- Laurel Caverns is 4.7 miles ahead
